- Approve April Minutes Emelia makes a motion to approve, Melva seconds, all vote in favor.
- Officer Elections Emelia is elected as President, Melva -Treasurer, and John Secretary.
- Guest: Owens Corning Link to Presentation
  - Multinational company Doors, installation, roofing shingles (asphalt based)
  - Been in the community for 48 years
  - Any non compliance in the last 5 years? No
  - Product goes directly from line to customers most of the time
  - Shingles are for existing roofs, not usually new construction
  - Asphalt is made out of petroleum, they "cook it" in order to process it
  - o Delivered by railcar and trucks, then they store it or sell it for roof repairs and resealing.
  - Not smoke coming out tower, it is steam water vapor
  - Problem is that asphalt is a smelly product, but not necessarily hazardous for you
  - But they understand that neighbors don't want to smell it
  - They have permits and are running within their permits and in compliance, but they know that the neighbors are smelling something.
  - 311 calls are good but OC doesn't hear about it for weeks and 311 doesn't provide the time odor occurs. They are looking for more data points
  - If humidity is over 50% and a SW wind it seems to cause the most problems, but they don't know why.
  - Is it truck traffic? Sometimes the trucks have to off gas so they don't implode, but they
    are their own company and are independent contractors.
  - If its humidity and wind direction they can get engineering help, but they need a lot of data points
  - Call 612-287-0118 to report any odors, Lynn will call you back if you ask her to.
  - They are down on Thursdays doing maintenance and took corrective actions for odor emissions during maintenance time.
  - EPA did an inspection as a result of the odor complaints, they didn't find anything
  - Is something vented into the stream, sand? OC does not produce into stream.
  - They do monthly inspections on storm water to monitor water and report to the state, nothing is directly piping out.
  - What positive impact do you have on the community? OC has a foundation that does Habitat for Humanity locally, they donate roofs to veterans, encourage employee volunteering, the local plant does Earth Day clean up events, donating \$5000 to the Creekview Center.
  - Could you time the truck deliveries for the middle of night so the odor doesn't affect neighbors? They will look into it.
  - o Can OC use exhaust pipes for the trucks to absorb exhaust? They will look into it.

- OC added filtration devices inside the plant and they've noticed improvement, they haven't had any complaints since they installed this.
- What are the potential harms of this? Chemical components, what you're smelling are nitrogen compounds and sulfur compounds, they are below health thresholds and in compliance with state and health guidelines.
- Standards are based on conservative experiences, minimum health threshold for sensitive populations. Standards are set by the State.
- OC will share some data on standards
- State is working to establish a odor management rule, <u>link</u>
- Next Owen's Corning application is in 2028
- o Board Tour July 10, wear close toed shoes, long pants, long shirts
